**17<sup>th</sup> April 2009**

On behalf of the Royal Thai Government, Thailand Convention and Exhibition Bureau (TCEB) as the official organization to attract Meetings, Incentives, Conventions, and Exhibitions fully appreciates the concerns you have raised over the current situation in Thailand of the recent political developments. The safety and security of our guests are our foremost concern.

We would like to inform you that regarding a severe emergency situation declared in Bangkok and its vicinities on 12 April 2009 in response to demonstrations which were organized by the United Front for Democracy Against Dictatorship (UDD), the protesters ended their demonstrations near Government House and other locations around Bangkok.

As of 14 April 2009, the situation has returned to normal with the Government firmly in control with peaceful resolution.

Business and mass transportation go on as usual and traffic is flowing normally in the capital. MICE events due to be held in Thailand will proceed according to schedule. All MICE venues, hotels, public and private organizations, shopping centres and restaurants are operating normally.

We at TCEB, on behalf of the government and our private sectors in the MICE Industry, will do our utmost to provide assistance to all delegates. We are sure you will take this opportunity during your stay to enjoy Thailand's legendary hospitality to the full.
